**POLICY**

This scholarship will be provided to a practicing nurse (RN, RPN, LPN) who resides North of the 53<sup>rd</sup> parallel and has been accepted into a program of study leading to a Degree in Nursing or Certificate.

**APPLICATION OF POLICY**

Applications with supporting documentation will be received between February 1<sup>st</sup> and March 31<sup>st</sup> of each year. ARNM will provide the award(s) within three months of the deadline dates. The amount of the scholarship will be consistent with The Winnipeg Foundation Funding Policy and approved by the ARNM Board of Directors in consultation with the ARNM Scholarship Committee. Board decisions are final; there is no appeal process

**SELECTION CRITERIA**

1. Practicing registration with CRNM / CLPNM / CRPNM
2. Current member of ARNM
3. Reside North of the 53<sup>rd</sup> parallel
4. Accepted to a program of study
5. Submitted an application as outlined below

**SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION**

1. Cover letter which outlines how you meet the selection criteria of the scholarship and how funding from ARNM will benefit you in your studies. This letter has no minimum but should be **no longer than 400 words**
2. Completed general application form
