

POLICY STATEMENT #5
Dennis D. Norbury - Obstetric or Palliative Care Scholarship
January 2026

POLICY

This scholarship will be dispersed annually to a practicing CRNM member who is enrolled in a Certificate or Graduate Study program with the focus of study being in or relevant to obstetrics or palliative care.

APPLICATION OF POLICY

Applications with supporting documentation will be received between February 1st and March 31st of each year. ARNM will provide the award(s) within three months of the deadline dates. The amount of the scholarship will be consistent with The Winnipeg Foundation Funding Policy and approved by the ARNM Board of Directors in consultation with the ARNM Scholarship Committee. Board decisions are final; there is no appeal process

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Practicing CRNM member
2. Current ARNM member
3. Accepted to a program of study
4. Work history in obstetrics or palliative care
5. Community service and volunteer work in obstetrics or palliative care
6. Involvement in professional/interest groups related to obstetrics or palliative care
7. Future career and academic goals related to obstetrics or palliative care

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

1. Cover letter which outlines how you meet the selection criteria of the scholarship and how funding from ARNM will benefit you in your studies. This letter has no minimum but should be **no longer than 400 words**.
2. Completed general application form
3. Copy of Institution or Program Letter of Acceptance/admission
